Official Death Announcement

The Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Republic of Liberia announces with profound regrets the death of Mrs. Klaneh Wesley Bruce, Deputy Consul General at the Consulate of the Republic of Liberia in New York, the United States of America.

This sad and mournful event occurred on September 22, 2017 at the Highland Hospital, Rochester, New York, USA.

Arrangements are underway to repatriate the remains of the late Mrs. Bruce back to Liberia, for funeral rites and interment.

Mrs. Klaneh Wesley Bruce, a career Foreign Service officer, joined the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, in the early 1980s as a Cadet and served in several capacities both at home and abroad until her sad demise.

There will be two funeral services- one in the US; the other in Liberia. The first funeral service will be held at the Heritage Christian Fellowship Church, 56 Chili Avenue, Rochester, New York 14611on Saturday, October 7, 2017 at the hour of 11 a.m.

The second funeral service will be held at the Empowerment Temple AME Church, Congo Town, Monrovia Liberia on Saturday, October 20, 2017 at 10 a.m.

Meanwhile, the Ministry of Foreign Affairs expresses its deepest condolences to the bereaved family and prays that the Almighty God will grant them solace during this period of mourning.
